## Sports Results and News

### Hockey

Last week saw the first boys' hockey games of the season. The U14s had two very tight games with Forest on Saturday, with the B team managing to procure a 2-0 win while the As were held to a 0-0 draw. The U13s had mixed fortunes against Forest, with the Ds securing a good win and the Cs a hard-fought draw, but the A and B teams were both beaten. Both the U15s and the Seniors have had a tough start to the season, facing extremely strong opposition in the form of Bishop's Stortford and Trinity School, Croydon in their cup competitions.

### Netball

Last week was a very busy week for Netball fixtures. All teams played Colfe's School throughout the week with U12s securing 2 wins and 3 loses, the U13s saw 4 wins and 1 draw, the U14s won 1 match, drew 1 match and lost 3 matches and the U15s won all 3 of their fixtures.
