Cricket

On Saturday both the U12A and B teams enjoyed wins against Chigwell. In the A team Dhruv Verma put in a noteworthy performance scoring 89 not out and Freddie Glyn contributed some lusty blows to the Bs' game.

Tennis

Congratulations to Anthony Wright (L4S) who represented Essex U14s in Blackpool at the weekend in the County Cup tennis event. His team won all their matches against the East of Scotland, Northumberland and Lancashire without dropping a set. The Essex team progress to the National Final which will be held in Nottingham in two weeks' time. Anthony currently has a 4.1 rating and is ranked 29 at U14 in Great Britain.

Bancroft's had a very successful week in the National Schools Team Tennis Competition with the U13 boys beating St Paul's and the U15 girls beating Clapton B team on a shoot-out tie-break before losing to their A team in another close shoot-out. The U18 boys excelled by beating Berkhamsted in the regional quarter final and take on Sandringham this week in the semi; Anthony Wright, David Nana, Gian Lakhan and Kail Francis were unbeaten in this tie. In school fixtures, the Senior girls and U15 girls played superbly against Chigwell, winning both fixtures comfortably – special mention should go to Emily Agarwal, Holly Timmis, Bhavleen Gill and Shavannah O'Connor who were unbeaten in their first school tennis fixture.

The U14s' Road To Wimbledon Singles Championships took place in a mixture of sun, rain, hail and ever-present wind! Krishan Parmar (L4E) and Tomisin Awoyode (RN) emerged as the champions for the second year in a row, defeating Nathan Adeyemo-Dakoh (3S) and Simran Chadda (3W) respectively in the finals. They all progress to the County Finals in July, when they will have the chance to play at Wimbledon if successful.
