Health and Wellbeing

Ways to look after emotional wellbeing	Students will be able to share a range of strategies for boosting emotional resilience.	Spring term
Who can help – support services	Students will be able to advise others on how and when to get help in dealing with emotional wellbeing and mental health concerns.	Spring term
Drugs and alcohol	Students will understand the different classes of drugs and how they link with alcohol and the legal consequences. They will understand about drug testing.	Spring term
How do I manage situations involving drugs?	Students will be able to identify the impact of 'risk' taking with drugs from the talk. They will know how to assess and manage risky situations involving drugs. They know where to get help and support.	Spring term
Peer pressure	Students will understand what peer pressure is and how to manage potential situations involving peer pressure.	Spring term

Choices Around Sex	Students will explore the reasons why people have sex. They will understand their choices around sex and be able to explain some of the 'issues' around early sex.	Summer term
Safe sexual relationships – contraception and STI's (2 lessons)	Students will be able to identify the facts and myths around contraception and be able to name a variety of types of contraception. Students will understand the key facts about STI's	Summer term

Gangs and knife crime	Students will know how to carry out research and present their findings on issues which may affect people of their age Students will understand the impact of knife crime and gangs on society: locally, nationally and globally.	Autumn term
Gender Identity	Students will understand what gender identity means. Students will be aware of the negative consequences of stereotypes and prejudice.	Autumn term
How can I contribute to my community?	Students will have an understanding of community services and who provides them. They will be able to name ways volunteers contribute to their communities.	Autumn term
